

Information sheet

When you book a course, you must be a member of the Parents' Association and pay the membership fee of €30 per school year and per family.

You must also purchase PA membership when booking external courses directly with the course leaders.

You can book and pay for the course and membership online on our website.

Only ESK students may participate in our courses. Any child, as long as their age is appropriate, can attend the course. Many courses are held in several languages.

If the minimum number of participants is not reached, the PA reserves the right to cancel the course. In this case, the course fees will be refunded.

Once the stated maximum number of participants has been reached, the course can no longer be booked. A place cannot be reserved.

After booking, your child can attend the course once for a trial lesson. If not satisfied, you will get your money back.

In the event of cancellation on their part, there is no entitlement to a refund of the course fee.

If your child is not allowed to go home alone, please pick him/her up at the blue gate in front of the school on time after the course. It is not possible to pick up your child at school without permission from the school.

Tell your child that he/she must stay with the course leader during the course and is not allowed to walk around the school grounds alone.

The Parents' Association or the course leader will inform you by e-mail if a course is cancelled.

If your child is unable to attend and you have to cancel, sign them out directly with the course leader. This also applies to school events (e.g. school trips, Christmas parties etc.).

If a course is cancelled by us at short notice, your children will be looked after by the MoMi during the actual course time, even if they are not registered there. This does not apply to participants of external courses.

No compensation can be given for cancelled days on the part of the participants or the course leaders.

Terms:

External courses: courses where the course instructor signs a contract directly with the parents, organises and bills himself/herself. (currently: Music Island, Violin, Piano, Ballet and English).

School semester courses: These courses only run for one term and start again in the 2nd term. The children must be re-registered if they wish to continue attending the course. (currently: swimming, art, STEM, robotics, children's cooking club).

School year courses: These courses run for the whole school year after one registration. If these courses are fully booked, a place must first become available in order to be able to book the course.
